Rules:

World Sailing, Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020
PMYC 2018 general racing rules (yearbook)

Eligible Yachts:

Any yacht with a PHRF Northwest handicap number.
For yachts in the cruiser/racer division, a PHRF number will be assigned by the race committee if none currently exists.

Program:

9:30am Saturday last minute on the water registration (w/ Fees) in baggy
10:00am (approx.) Saturday, race warning signal.
5:30pm Saturday, dinner on the floating dock in the Bremerton Marina.
9:00am (approx.) Sunday, race warning signal.

Course:

Saturday: Start of Point Monroe in a southerly direction, proceed around Bainbridge keeping the Island to starboard. **Restriction;** Leave the Decatur Reef buoy at Restoration Point to starboard. Then proceed to the finish line East of the entrance of the Bremerton Marina.

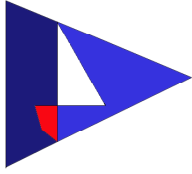
Sunday: Start of Heron Point in a northeasterly direction and proceed North through Port Orchard Narrows and beneath the Agate Pass bridge keeping Bainbridge Island to Starboard to the finish line off from the entrance in Hidden Cove.

Light Air at the Start: The starting may be moved along the rhumbline of the course to facilitate completing the race on time

Shorten Course: The days race may be shortened at any location approximately in the rhumbline of the course.

Individual recalls: an attempt will be made to announce individual recalls over the VHF at the committees convenience.

General recalls: Return to the starting line for a new starting sequence.



Time limits: 5:00 on Saturday. 3:00 on Sunday.

Radio: Race announcements will be broadcast on channel 72

Classes and starting sequence:

Div. III, cruiser/racer division, all sizes, number 3 code flag

Div. II, PHRF 141 and above, number 2 code flag

Div. I, PHRF 140 and below, number 1 code flag

Scoring:

The race will be scored as a combined time of both race days. Each division will receive trophies to third place. Trophies will awarded at the annual meeting or mailed if address is provided.

Social:

Dinner will be provided for Saturday night in the shelter on the floats in the Bremerton Marina. Dinner is \$15.00 for adults, \$8.00 for kids under 10.

If you register online and have additional crew, please pay for the additional crew before you eat (cash or check only.)

Moorage in Bremerton: A limited number of spaces have been reserved at the marina. Please contact Bremerton Marina to pre-pay your slip.

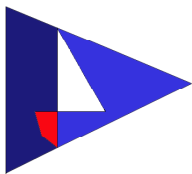
