Or Deliver Registration Form to the race committee boat by 9:30 AM

Division 1- PHRF 140 and below

Division 2 PHRF 141 & above.

Division 3 Non-Flying Sails.

COURSES: Race Committee will determine Course 30 minutes prior to start. The number pennant indicating course selection (1-3) will be displayed on the bow of the committee boat. All starting flags will be displayed on the stern of the committee boat.

Course 1 (16.1 NM)

- Start line off Pt Monroe.
- Round (leave to port) temporary yellow race mark 1/2 NM West of dock at Jefferson Head, N 47° 44' 20" W 122° 29' 38".
- Round (leave to port) Red Nun Buoy off Restoration Point.
- Finish line off Eagle Harbor Marina.

Course 2 (13.1 NM)

- Start line off Pt Monroe.
- Round (leave to port) Yellow mid channel buoy (between Alki Pt & Restoration Pt.).
- Finish line off Eagle Harbor Marina.

Course 3 (9.5 NM)

- Start line off Pt Monroe.
- Round (leave to port) Blakely Rock.
- Finish line off Eagle Harbor Marina.

Note: The race may be shortened at any mark of the course. (Monitor Channel 72)

STARTING: **First warning 10:00 AM.** 1ST Start 10:05 Division 1 (140 & Below), 2nd Start 10:10 Division 2 (141 & Above), 3rd Start 10:15 Division 3 (Non-flying Sails).

TIME LIMIT: Five hours. Yachts finishing after the time limit will be scored as DNF

SCOREING: Time on Distance Scoring will be used. This Race counts as Race #5 in the PMYC 2010 Season Series.

RACING RULES: Instructions and starting sequence – as stated in current US Sailing Rules except as otherwise noted in these instructions.

COMMUNICATION: Race committee will monitor VHF channel 72.

SOCIAL: This event should provide fun sailing and a chance for the 3 clubs to socialize together afterward. The BIYC Club House (@ Eagle Harbor Marina, 5834 Ward Ave NE) adjacent to the finish line will host a "bring your own" Bar-b-que and potluck immediately following the racing. Participants should bring something to share (no specific assignments). Members of the 3 clubs who are not participating in the race are encouraged to still attend the social. The finish line is set up to allow good viewing from the club house deck or down on the dock. Depending on wind conditions, boats could begin finishing as early as 1:30 PM.

Officials at the finish will direct skippers to guest moorage available for visiting boats event.

ENTRY FEE: No entry fee for racing portion will be collected.
