RACE RULES FOUND IN THE 2019 PMYC YEARBOOK UNLESS ALTERED BY THESE INSTRUCTIONS

REGISTRATION: Please RSVP wmbwalker@gmail.com with: (1) boat name, (2) sail number, (3) division, (4) PHRF Rating and (5) skipper's name, (6) Cell phone # **Or** Deliver Registration Form to the race committee boat by 8:45AM Division 1- PHRF 140 and below Division 2 PHRF 141 & above. Division 3 Non-Flying Sails.

MOORAGE: Make reservations at the Port Ludlow Marina (360 437 0513) ASAP. PMYC has a limited number of slips reserved. Upon arrival, you may call in on VHF channel 68 to get slip assignment.

COURSE: Saturday Start off Pt Monroe. Keep Jefferson Head, Apple Cove Point, Pilot Point, Point No Point, and Foulweather Bluff to port. Finish off Tala Point—within 100 yards of Port Ludlow Light (Dolphin pilings) which is approx W122°39.67' N47°56.71' (**not** the Colvos Rock Buoy). This will be a self timed finish. Please see attached map.

Sunday The reverse course of Saturday. Keep all marks to starboard.

Note: If conditions are adverse for either start, the starting line may be moved closer to the finish. The race may also be shortened at any mark of the course. (Monitor Channel 72). Jim Llewellyn will set the finish line in Port Madison.

DISTANCE: 19 nautical miles each way, unless course is shortened

STARTING: Saturday First warning 8:55 AM for all Divisions. Start 9:00am all Divisions. Sunday First warning 10:30 AM for all Divisions. Start 10:35am all Divisions.

Starting Sequence: Call to attention: multiple horn blasts

Yellow flag (with 1 horn blast) –
Blue flag raised (with 1 horn blast) -
Blue flag lowered (with 1 long horn blast) -
Start (yellow flag lowered with 1 horn blast)

5 minute warning signal 4 minute preparatory signal 1 minute Signal

TIME LIMIT: Eight hours. Yachts finishing after the time limit will be scored as DNF

SCORING: A sum of a boat's Saturday & Sunday corrected times (Time on Distance) will be their final score. A boat that is DNF or OCS will be scored with the time of the slowest corrected finish time plus 1 hour. This Race counts as Races #3 and #4 in the PMYC 2019 Season Series.

COMMUNICATION: Race committee will monitor VHF channel 72 and it is **strongly suggested that participants monitor channel 72** for possible racing updates such as course shortenings, premature starters, starting line changes, finishing information, gossip, and group consultations. **RC** cell phone – 206 406-5800 (Bill) for Saturday, and 206-450-0101(Jim Llewellyn) on Sunday
